The National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID), one of the largest institutes of the world-renowned National Institutes of Health (NIH), seeks several highly motivated individuals to serve as scientific review officers (SROs) in the Division of Extramural Activities Scientific Review Program.

Candidates should have strong basic research or clinical backgrounds in one or more of the following areas: infectious diseases; cellular/molecular aspects of immunology, virology, or microbiology; autoimmunity or transplantation research; parasitology; epidemiology; HIV/AIDS pathogenesis; antimicrobial drug discovery or development; vaccine discovery or development; or allergy/asthma research. Candidates with significant experience in other biomedical research related to NIAID's mission, including translational research, are also welcome to apply.

An SRO's principal role is to manage the scientific peer review of grant and cooperative agreement applications and contract proposals assigned to NIAID for primary merit review. The SRO will assess each submission for completeness, will evaluate the types of science and technology represented, and then will select, assign, instruct, and oversee the extramural panels of experts who identify the most meritorious applications and proposals for potential award. To support review panel decisions, SROs provide Institute staff with clear, concise, written documentation of the results of peer review deliberations. SROs also serve authoritatively to interpret, implement, and ensure adherence to HHS, NIH, and NIAID policies governing the peer review of extramural research programs and to help develop and evaluate new Institute initiatives.


