MDR *Pseudomonas* pneumonia – stem cell transplant recipient
Clostridium novyi bacteremia - metastatic colon cancer
Neck abscess
FUO and persistent neutropenia – stem cell transplant recipient
Serratia bacteremia/cholangitis - Klatskin tumor
Postobstructive pneumonia – lung cancer
Bacillus spp. AICD pocket infection
Polymicrobial soft tissue infection and osteomyelitis - IVDA
Leukocytosis and *Pseudomonas* UTI – intraaortic balloon pump
Enterobacter pneumonia - LVAD
Acute Lyme disease
Disseminated TB
Group A strep toxic shock syndrome
Candida, *Pseudomonas putida* catheter-related infection
Pseudomonas bacteremia/pneumonia – heart transplant recipient
Leukocytosis post-diskectomy
Osteomyelitis
CMV pneumonitis – renal transplant recipient
Catheter-related *Stenotrophomonas* bacteremia
MRSA skin abscess
AICD pocket infection
Aspiration pneumonia
Cranial nerve palsies and FUO – HIV/AIDS
History of Lyme with migratory myalgias
MSSA post-operative meningitis
Possible *Legionella* pancreatitis
MSSA and *Staphylococcus epidermidis* bacteremia - ESRD
Osteomyelitis with persistent MRSA bacteremia - ESRD
Renal failure following GI illness in veterinary worker
VRE mediastinitis
VRE bacteremia
Postoperative leukocytosis
MSSA postoperative septic arthritis
R/o TB
MRSA endocarditis/osteomyelitis
MSSA tricuspid valve endocarditis - IVDA
AV graft infection
Possible EBV-related lymphoma – HIV-AIDS
Neutropenic fever and pulmonary nodules

Coagulase-negative *Staphylococcus* bacteremia with pacemaker
Postoperative soft-tissue infection with mesh in place
MRSA/*Pseudomonas* BKA stump infection
Group A streptococcal cellulitis
Dialysis catheter tip thrombus, ?infection
Proteus/MRSA infection - LVAD
CMV PCR 14K, ?treatment – HIV/AIDS
Cryptococcal meningitis, CMV PCR+, RPR+ - HIV/AIDS
VRE/*Pseudomonas* catheter-related bacteremia
Cellulitis/osteomyelitis
MSSA postoperative infection of spine hardware
H/o pulmonary MAI with bilateral pneumonia
VRE bacteremia and liver abscess – liver cancer
Postoperative intrabdominal abscess
VRE/gram-negative bacteremia - liver transplant recipient
Osteomyelitis
Enterococcus-infected hematoma at LVAD pocket site
Recalcitrant MSSA septic arthritis
Sepsis - liver transplant recipient
Pneumonia - lung transplant recipient
Septic arthritis involving joint hardware
Klebsiella pneumonia
Mold in blood culture - lymphoma
Postoperative MRSA subgaleal empyema
Hepatitis from oxacillin therapy
MRSA osteomyelitis
MDR gram-negative bacteremia
Fungal endocarditis
Pseudomonas pneumonia
Polymicrobial bacteremia/fungemia, likely self-inoculation
Chylous leak following vascular surgery
Osteomyelitis
Candidemia
Fever following brain surgery
MSSA bacteremia
Necrotizing granuloma in gastric biopsy - rule out infectious cause
Postoperative meningitis/bacteremia/MRSA soft-tissue infection
Postoperative wound infection involving hardware
E. coli-infected hematoma at LVAD pocket site
Third ventricle cyst in Central American patient
GC urethritis, fever, leukocytosis
Bilateral lung infiltrates and nodules - CLL
Coagulase-negative *Staphylococcus* and MRSA LVAD infection

Pleural drain growing *Pasteurella*
Postoperative soft tissue infection
Acute cholecystitis, liver abscess – colon cancer
MRSA catheter-related bacteremia
Lactic acidosis and colitis
Rat bite fever in returning traveler
Drug rash on nafcillin
Pseudomonas sternal wound infection
Pleural TB?
AFB+ culture of peritoneal fluid - peritoneal dialysis
MRSA breast implant infection
Coagulase-negative *Staphylococcus* LVAD infection
